

COURSES FOR STUDENTS

KNIFE AWARENESS

This interactive presentation allows young people to debate about knives and weapons and shows



them the dangers and possible consequences of carrying and using them. This hard hitting and educational lesson makes a great contribution to the Government's drive to reduce knife crimes.

CONFLICT RESOLUTION

Many fights can be avoided. Young people often cannot see the consequences of their actions. High profile gang beatings have resulted in death. The Law on self defence, active listening skills and how to avoid a fight are covered in detail in this enlightening and entertaining lesson.

ANGER MANAGEMENT

A new course for students who have anger issues. Designed in consultation with experts in A.M., the course aims to assist the individual to control themselves in times of conflict but also to vent their anger in a safe environment as an aid to self-control.

"LIFE IN THE FAST LANE"

This is an interactive course for school leavers or students living on their own for the first time in a new environment. The student will learn personal management skills they can use when walking in the street, living in shared accommodation, in clubs, or driving or travelling on their own. A helping hand to independent living.

All of these courses can be tailored to fit in with school lesson times as required.



COURSES FOR STAFF

KNIFE AWARENESS

Level 1 : 4 Hours

An Introduction to the Law relating to knives; types of knives and bladed instruments; the comparison between knives and guns; the Law relating to self defence; and the injuries caused by knives. This will include basic techniques to use in the event of a knife attack.



Level 2 : 1 day

In addition to the content of Level 1, the student will undertake a 4 hour session of responses to a spontaneous knife attack. This is a very physical session in a closely controlled and monitored environment. The student will learn how knives are used by skilled and unskilled attackers and practice dynamic responses to the attack.

SAFE SEARCHING "IT'S THE LAW!"



When the Government gave Head Teachers, or people they designate, the power to search pupils without their consent and screen them for weapons,

RPL Safety Consultancy created a training course on safe searching. On completion of this course, designated teachers will be able to search and screen pupils and legally record their action. This Course is 4 hours long and at least 2 people of each gender should attend.

COURSES FOR STAFF

CONFLICT RESOLUTION

Level 1 : 4 hours

This course is suitable for Teachers who may have to deal with someone displaying aggressive behaviour. Shopkeepers, Council and Leisure Industry workers have all benefitted from this session. The course looks at ritualised combat; warning signs and danger signs; physiological responses; methods of defusing confrontation; personal safety; the Law relating to self defence and how to write a report of an incident.

Level 1 + Restraining Techniques : 1 day

This course looks at a variety of techniques of Restraint; working alone and in teams, in addition to the content of Conflict Resolution Level 1. It is aimed at Teachers and staff who may have to deal with physical conflict and restrain people using minimum force with maximum effect and most importantly of all, within the Law.



Level 2 : 1 day

A full day's course incorporating the content of Level 1 with the addition of breakaway techniques and Spontaneous Response Training: (using a man in a padded suit to simulate an attack and adapting the spontaneous response of the student to become an effective defence). This is a very physical lesson and incredibly valuable to the individual.
