The courses offered by RPL Safety Consultancy:-

Knife Awareness	Level 1	4 hrs	An Introduction to the Law relating to knives; the types of knives and bladed instruments; the comparison between knives and guns; the Law relating to self defence; injuries and damage caused by knives. This will include basic techniques to use in the event of a knife attack.
Knife Awareness	Level 2	1 day	In addition to Level 1, the student will undertake a 4 hour session in responses to a spontaneous knife attack. This is a very physical course but closely controlled and monitored session. The student will learn how knives are used by skilled and unskilled attackers and practice dynamic responses to the attack.
Safe Searching		4 hrs	When the Government gave Head Teachers, or people they designate, the power to search pupils without their consent and screen them for weapons, RPL Safety Consultancy created a training course on safe searching. On completion of this course, designated teachers will be able to search and screen pupils and to legally record their action. A full 'Search Pack' of all Forms required, guidance notes and a metal detector can be purchased through the trainer.
Conflict Resolution	Level 1	4 hrs	This course is suitable for Teachers and anyone working in the public sector who may deal with someone displaying aggressive behaviour. Shopkeepers, Council workers and the Leisure industry have all benefitted from this lesson. The course looks at ritualised combat; warning signs and danger signs; physiological responses; methods of diffusing confrontation; personal safety; the law relating to self defence and how to write a report of an incident.
Conflict resolution Restraint - the 'caring way'		4 hrs	This course looks at a variety of techniques of restraint and follows on from Level 1 for Teachers, staff and other public sector workers who may have to deal with physical conflict and restrain people using minimum force with maximum effect.

Conflict Resolution Lone worker	Level 2	1 day A day's course including Level 1, breakaway techniques and Spontaneous Response Training:(using a man in a padded suit to simulate an attack and adapting the spontaneous response of the student to become an effective defence). This is a very physical lesson.
"Life in the Fast Lane"		2 hrs This is an interactive course for school leavers or students living on their own for the first time in a new environment. The student will learn personal management skills for walking in the street, living in shared accommodation, in clubs, when driving or travelling on their own. Staying as safe as possible is a vital part of personal development and this course helps to identify some of the pitfalls and how to avoid or overcome them.
"The Ultimate Security Course"		1 day This course takes the student to new levels of understanding about the Law on self defence. It goes into meticulous detail about how and when to use force. The Violent Incident Analysis Model ensures that, if force is used or threatened, the student will be able to evidence any action taken. The afternoon is dedicated to 'hands on' techniques using the best of 25 years of 'Police Self Defence' holds. The day concludes with the students working as a team to 'relocate' a violent individual. If any course is designed for the people working in the Security Industry, then this is it.
